Member Update August 2015

2015 Return to Work SA (formerly WorkCover) Industry Levy Rates.

On 1st July 2015 the WorkCover Scheme was replaced with the Return to Work SA Scheme.

The employer levy system is based on an industry premium rate and in addition to that levy premium rate an employer's claims history is taken into account. An employer with no claims will be required to pay the industry rate only whereas a higher rate is paid by an employer who has had claims.

The industry rates for 2015-16 are stated to be a reduction for most employers than the rate paid in 2014-15 under the previous scheme. As reported in previous updates claims however will be costlier with the new Scheme.

Industry classifications and rates

The Return to Work SA Corporation has provided the information below to assist employers to check their levy rates.

South Australian Industry Classifications (SAIC) have replaced South Australian WorkCover Industrial Classifications (SAWICs).

The new SAICs align our industry-based classification system with the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC) 2006 ensuring:

- a modern classification system that reflects the changes and evolution in the structure and composition of industry over time
- we align with national workers' compensation harmonisation objectives.

We use an industry based classification system to assign an appropriate classification for each employer location, based on predominant business activity. This system is called the South Australian Industry Classification (SAIC) system.

Each SAIC has a corresponding <u>industry premium rate</u>, which is calculated each year using the claims cost performance of all businesses classified in that industry. An industry premium rate is not necessarily linked to the perceived risk involved for workers in that industry – it is linked to actual claims experience.

At the end of each financial year, we provide all employers with an Industry Premium Rate Schedule that details <u>industry premium rate/s</u> specific to their business as well as their SAICs. It is important to advise us of any changes to your business activity as this may lead to a change to your classification and a change to your industry premium rate.
